

Strengthening Peer-Led Outreach Among Key Populations

Abstract | Community & Peer Support

Peer-led outreach is central to how key populations in Kenya access health information and services. This abstract describes how trained peer leaders across the Consortiums member networks deliver accurate information, encouragement and safe referral pathways, designed by and for the communities they serve. It explores why community-sourced information builds trust, how peer models reach people who avoid formal services, and what is needed to sustain and scale peer capacity through training, supportive supervision and stronger links between networks.
